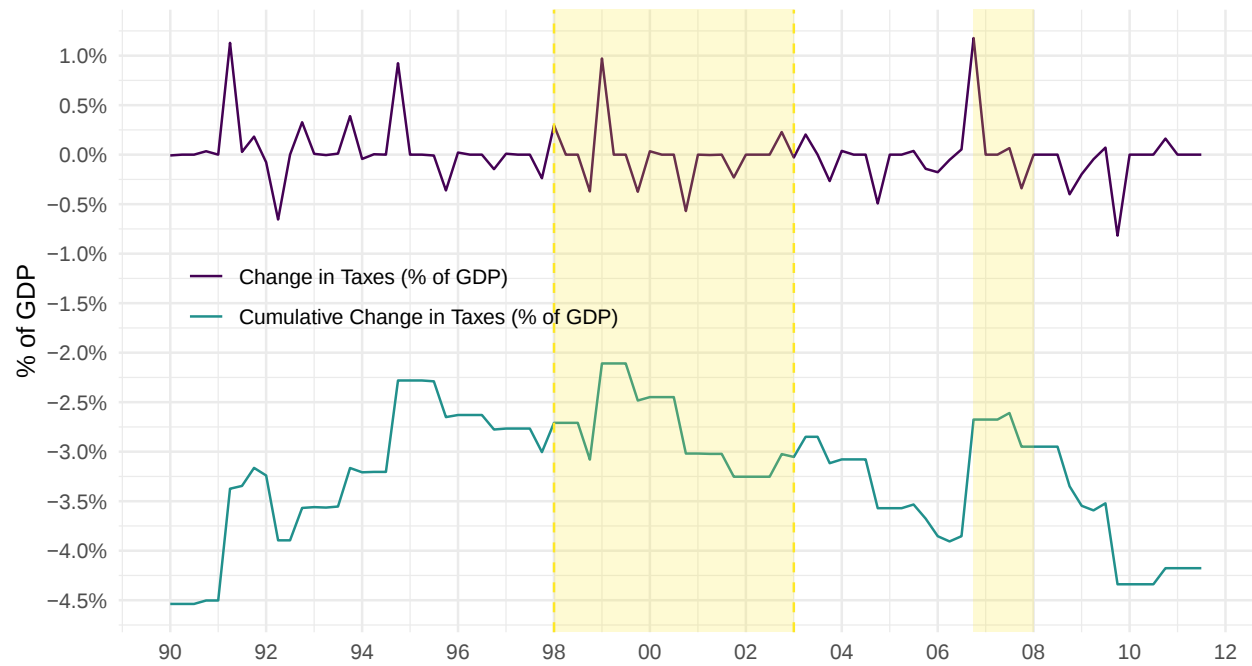


Figure 1: HAYO, UHL TAX SERIES (1990-2014)

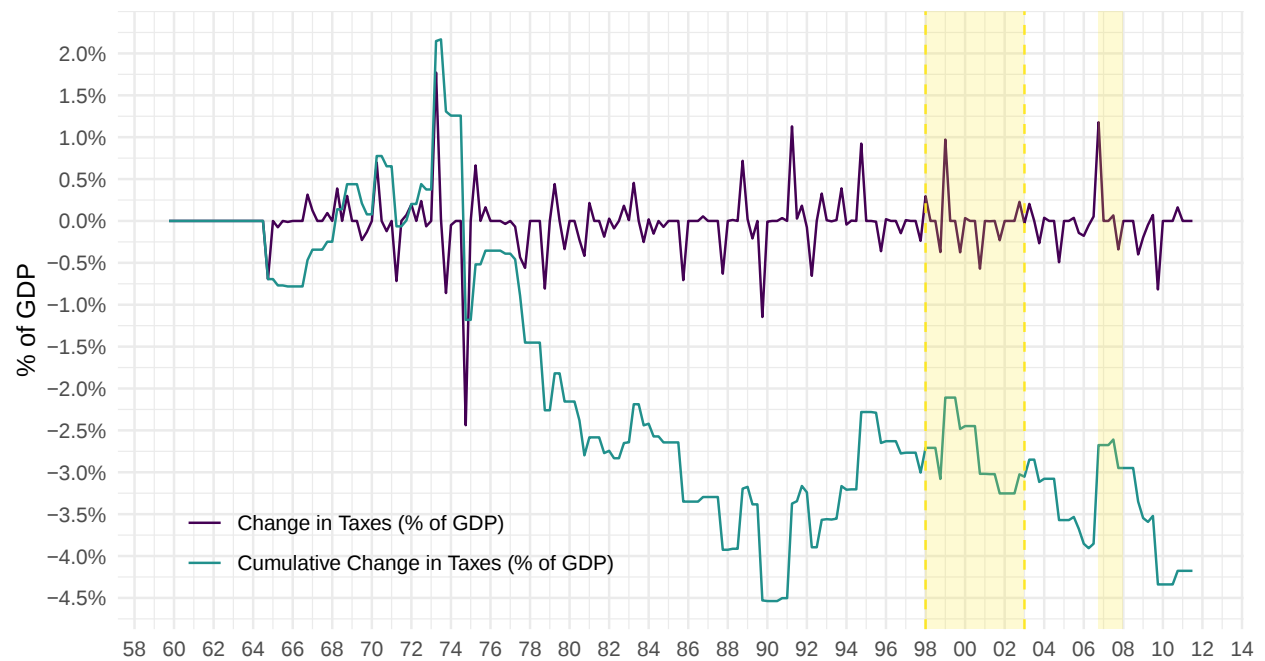


Figure 2: HAYO, UHL TAX SERIES (1990-2014)

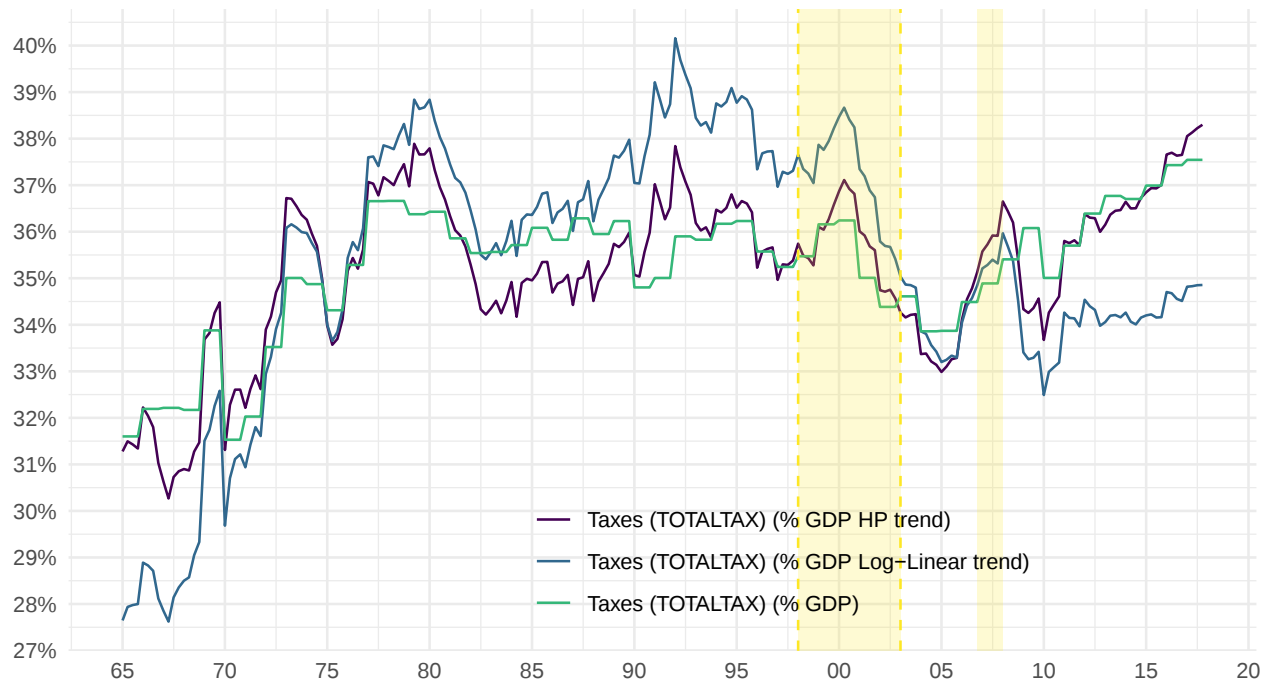


Figure 3: GERMANY

Value-Added Taxes (5000)

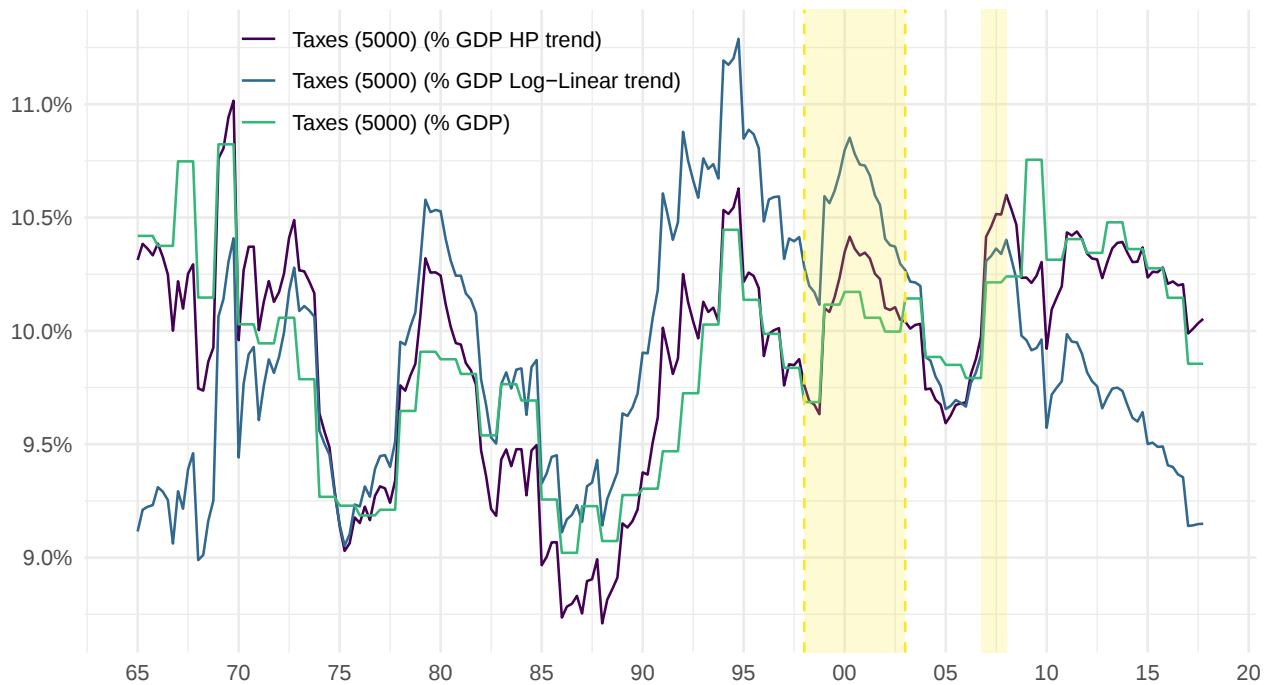


Figure 4: GERMANY

Taxes (5100)

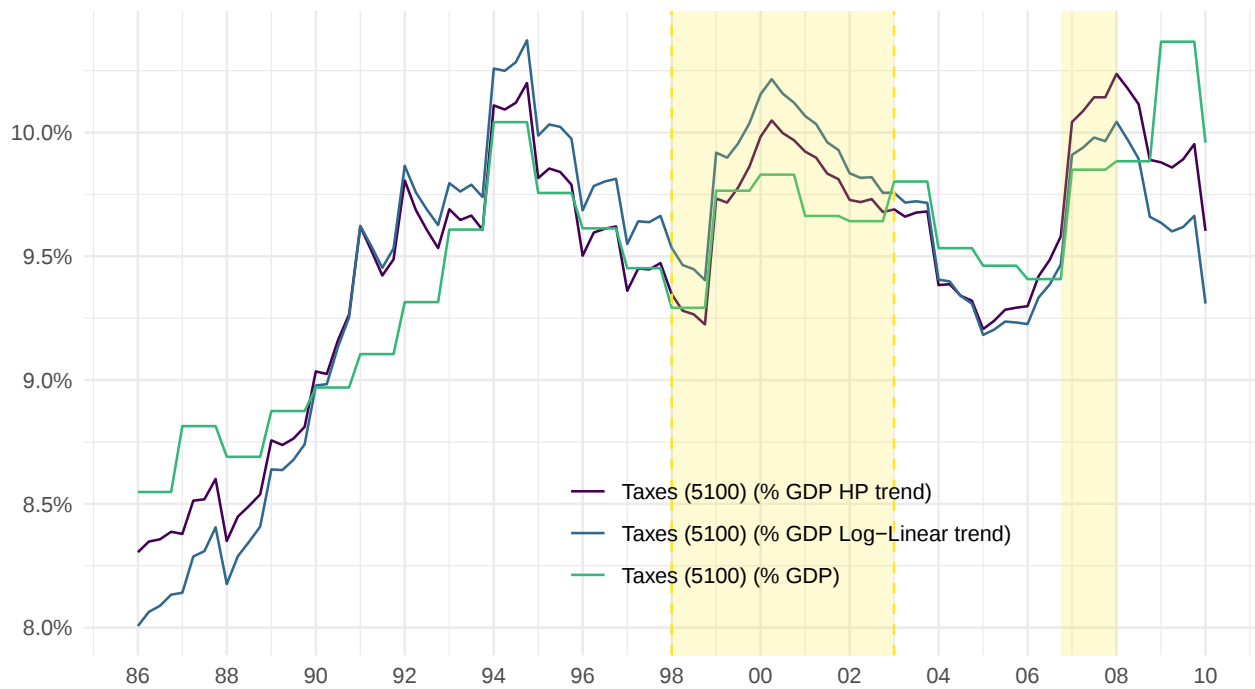


Figure 5: GERMANY

Taxes (5110)

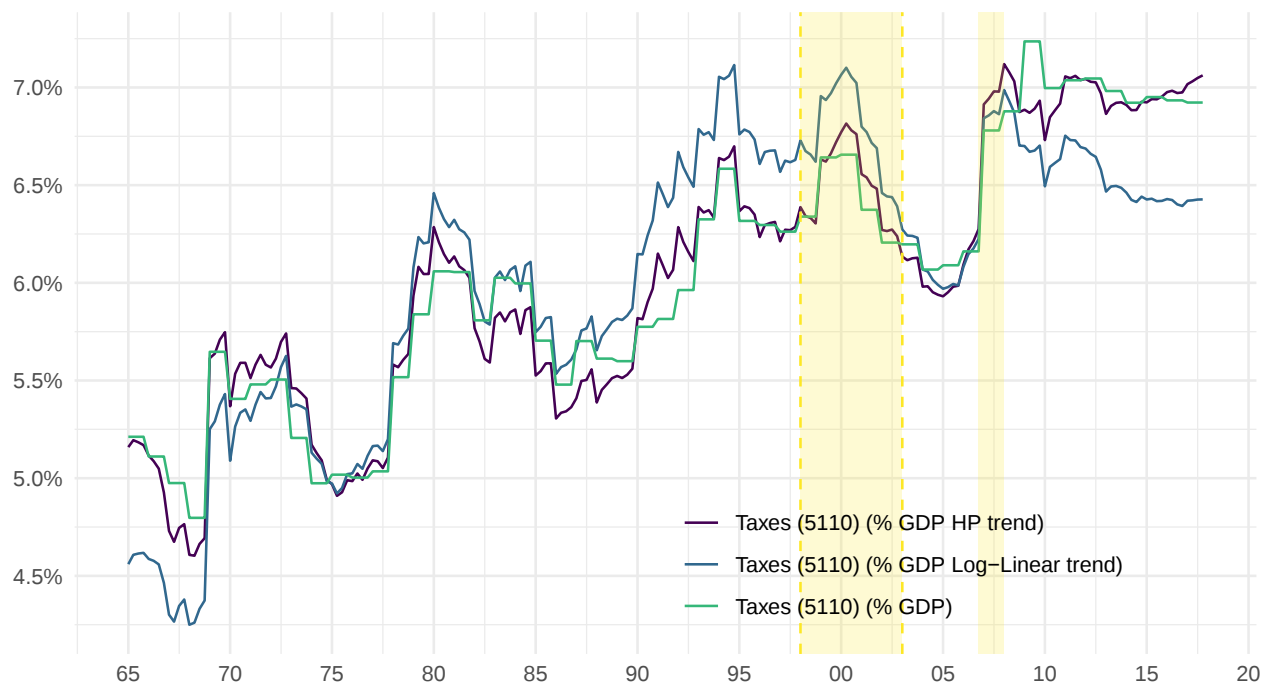


Figure 6: GERMANY

Taxes (5120)

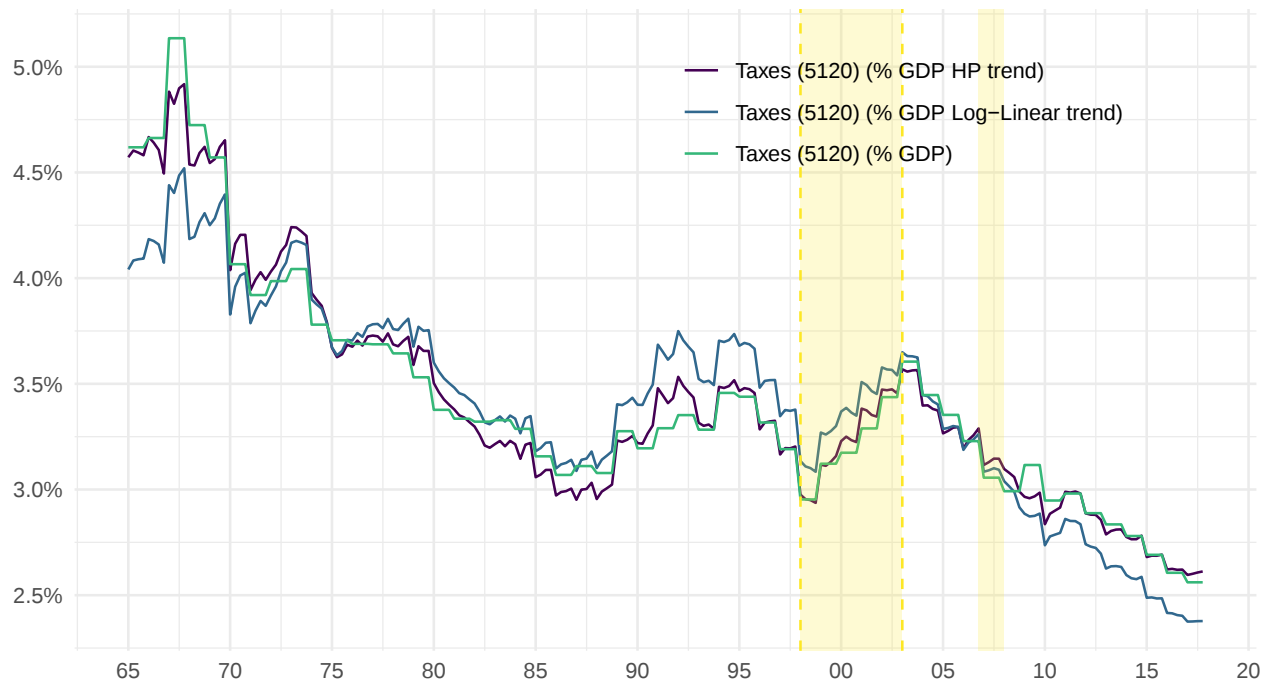
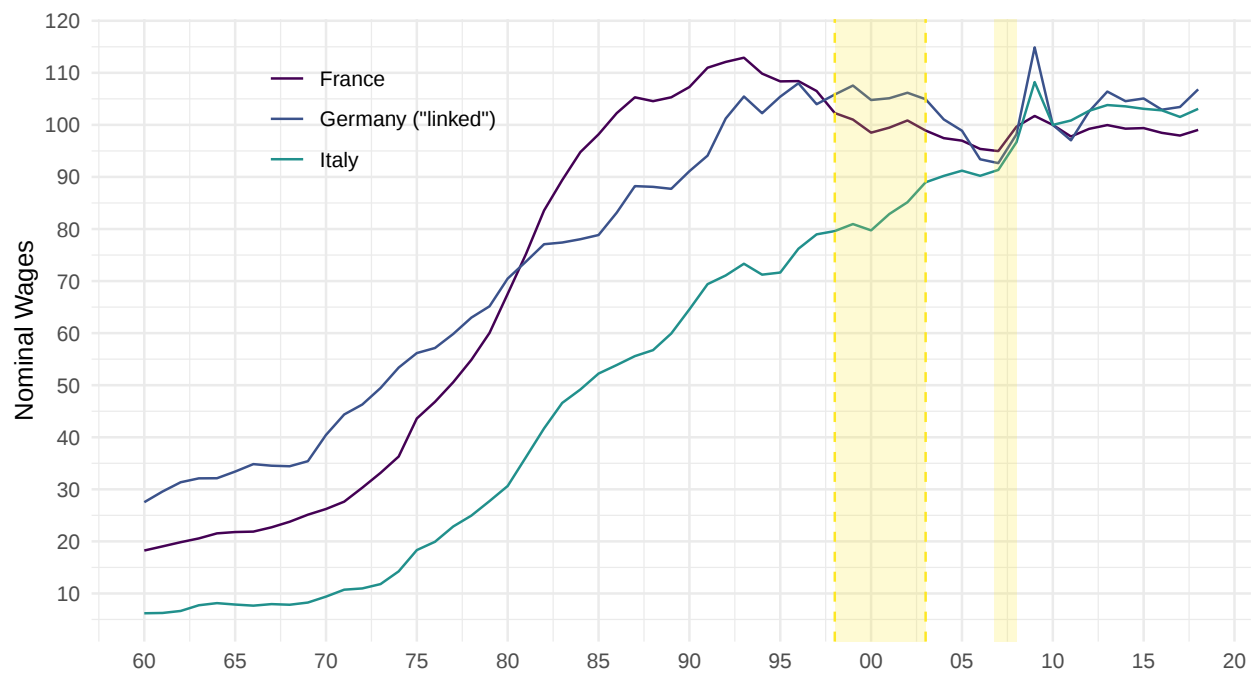


Figure 7: GERMANY

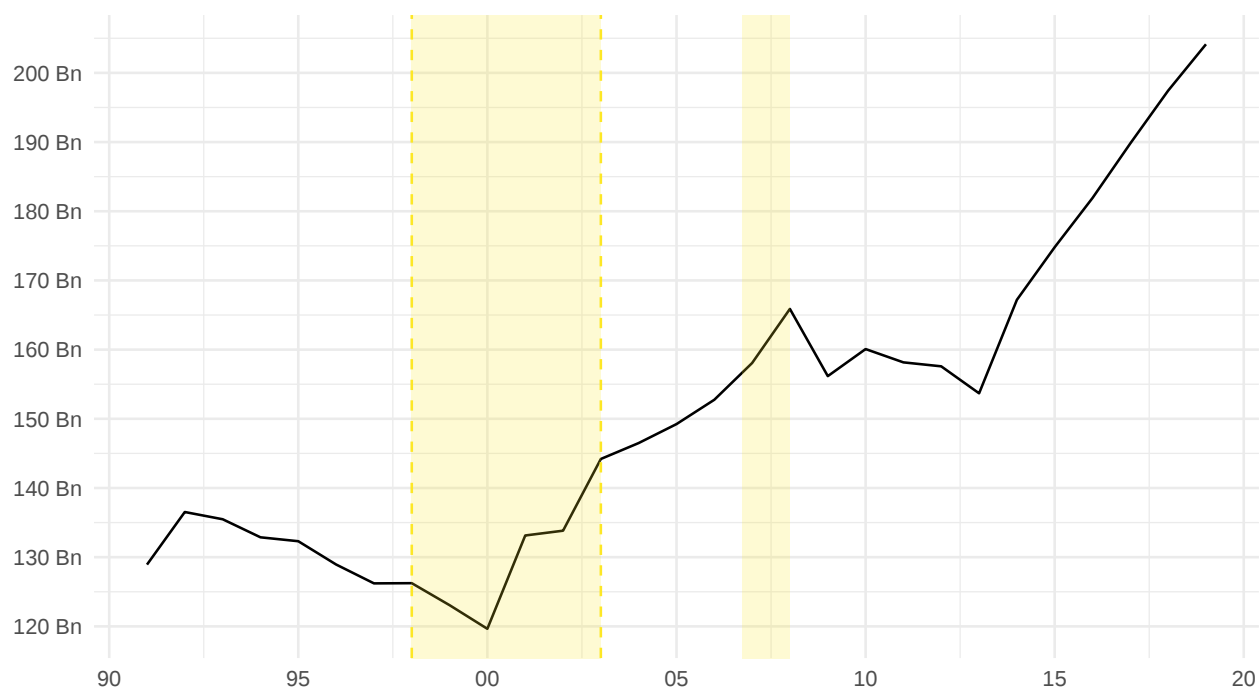


Figure 8: NET SAVING OF HOUSEHOLDS.

Net general government saving - SAVG

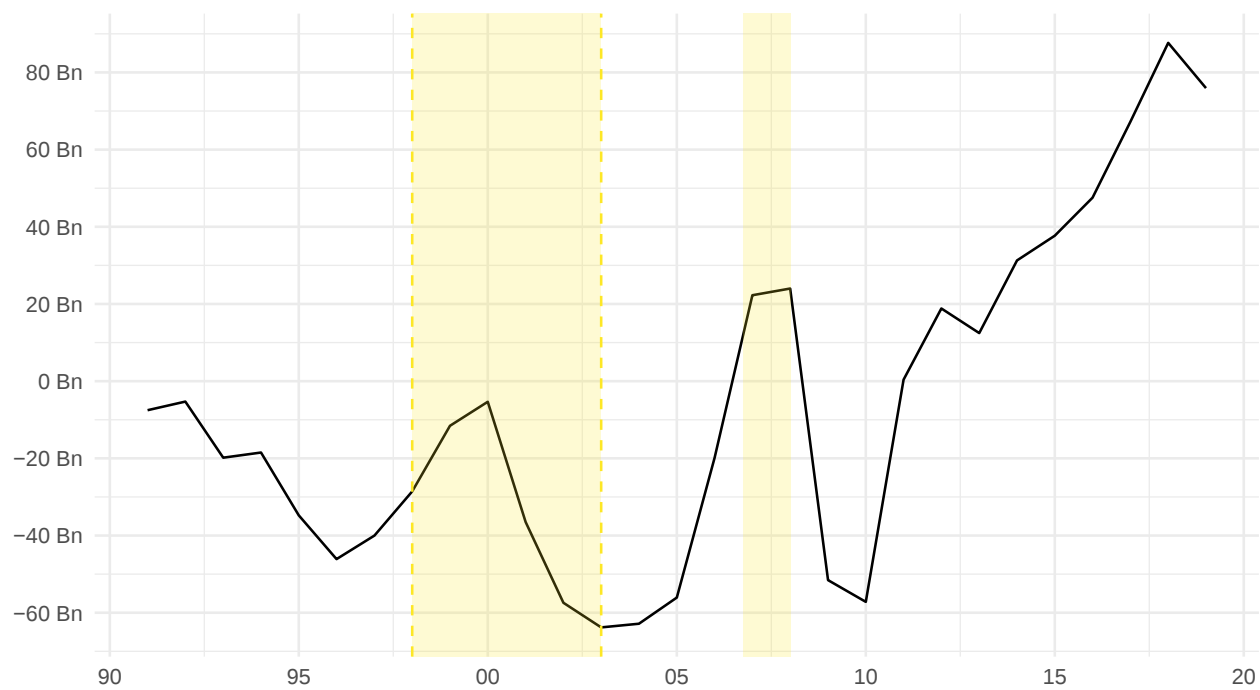


Figure 9: NET GENERAL GOVERNMENT SAVING.

Net Saving Ratio - SRATIO

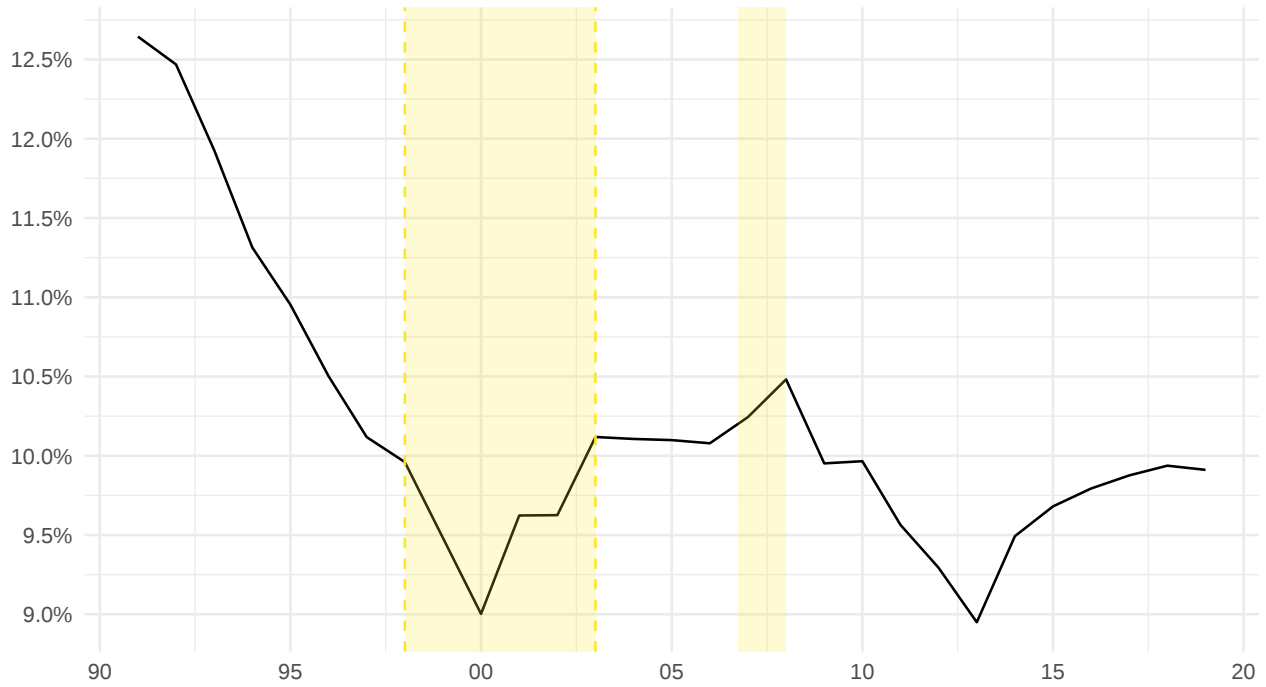


Figure 10: NET SAVING OF HOUSEHOLDS.

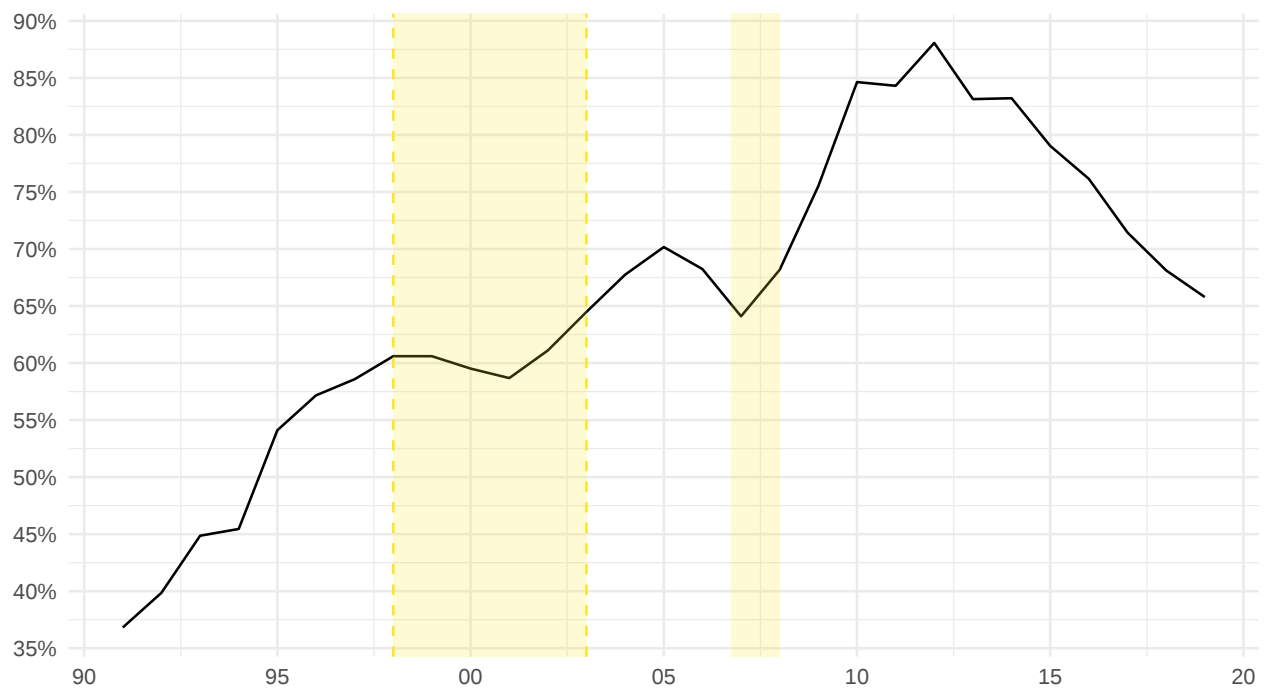


Figure 11: GROSS GOVERNMENT DEBT.

Net Government Debt - GNFLQ

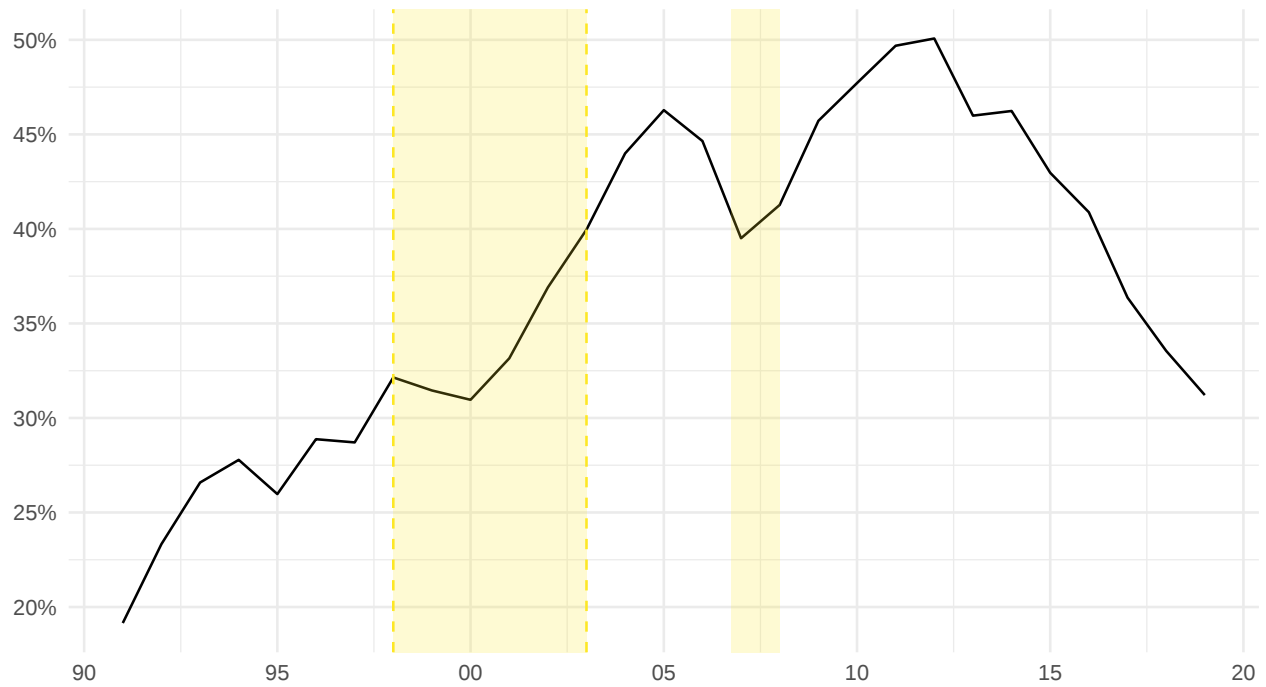


Figure 12: NET GOVERNMENT DEBT.

General government net lending - NLGQ

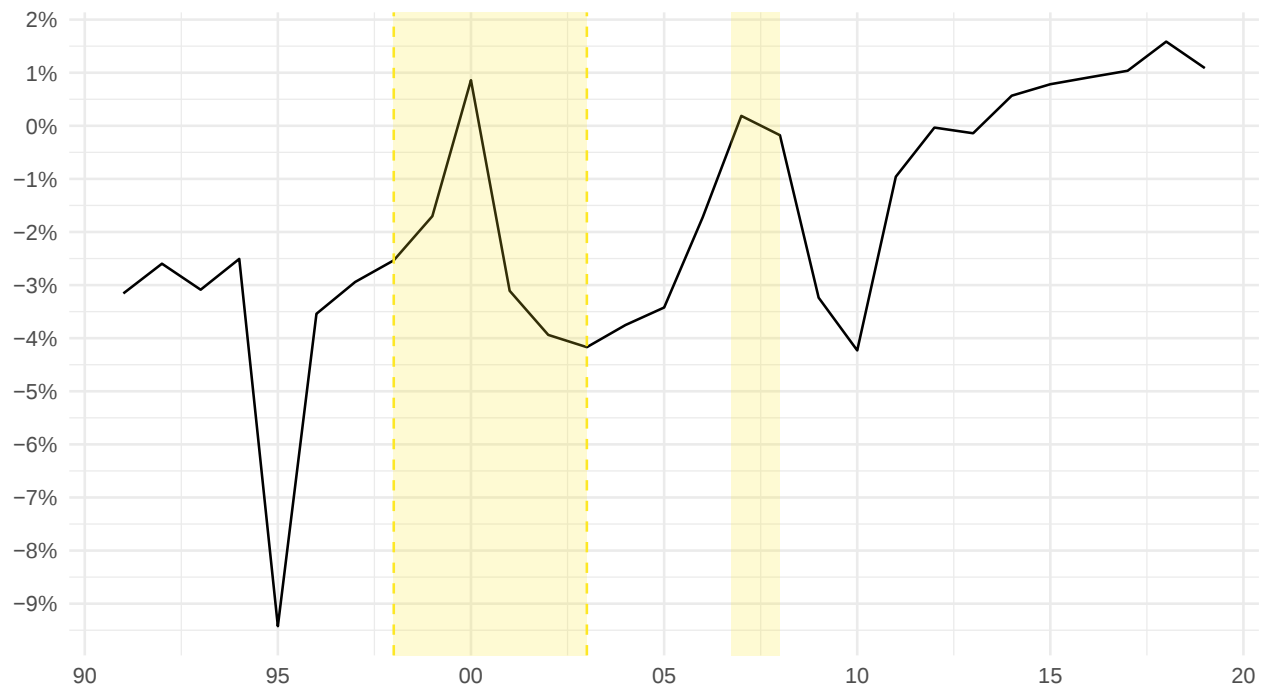


Figure 13: GENERAL GOVERNMENT NET LENDING AS A PERCENTAGE OF GDP.

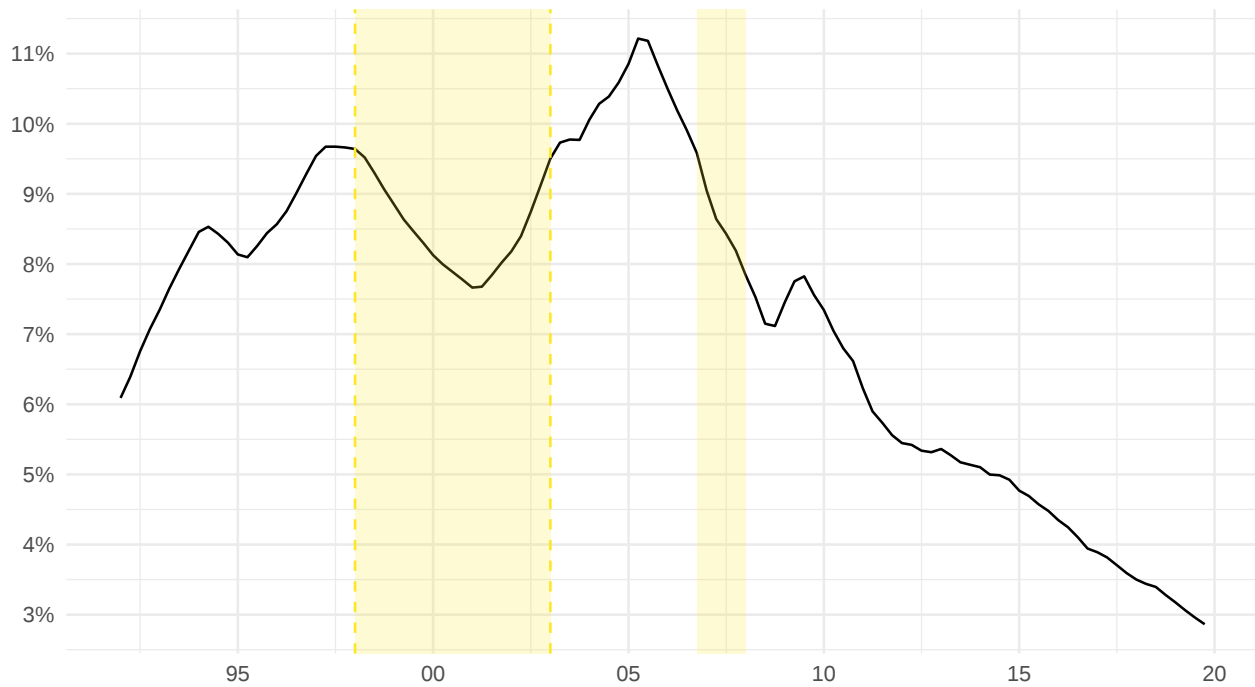


Figure 14: UNEMPLOYMENT.

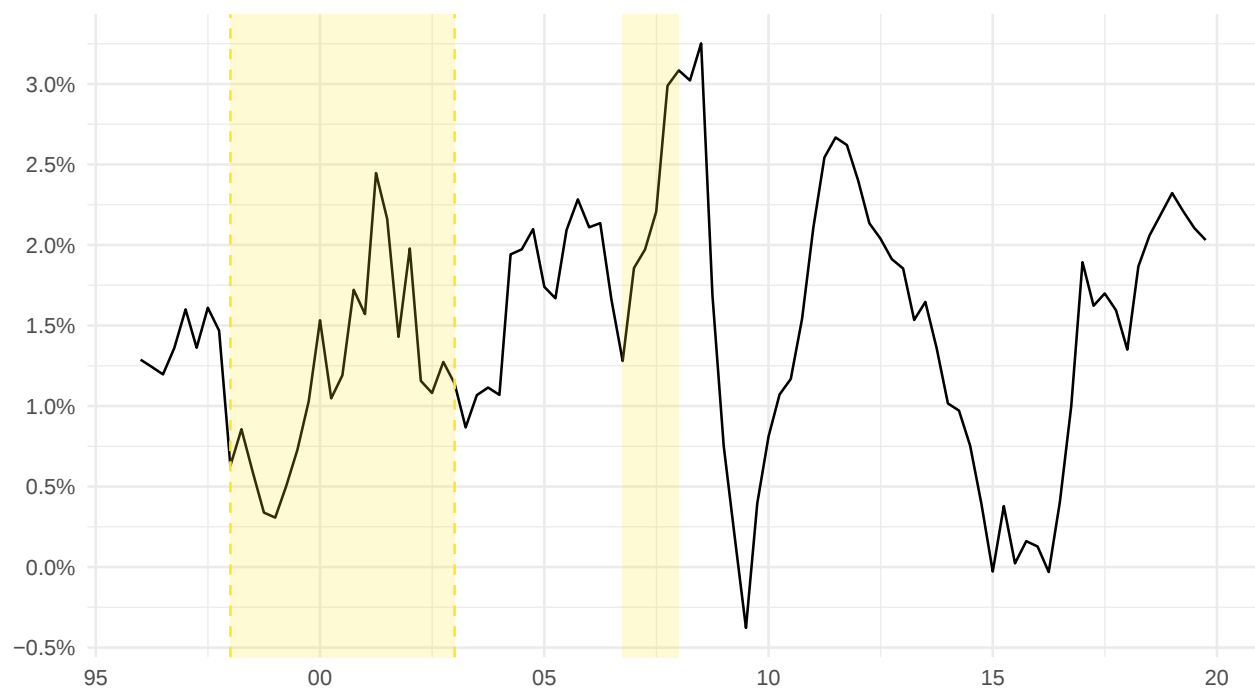


Figure 15: INFLATION.

Gross Domestic Product - GDP

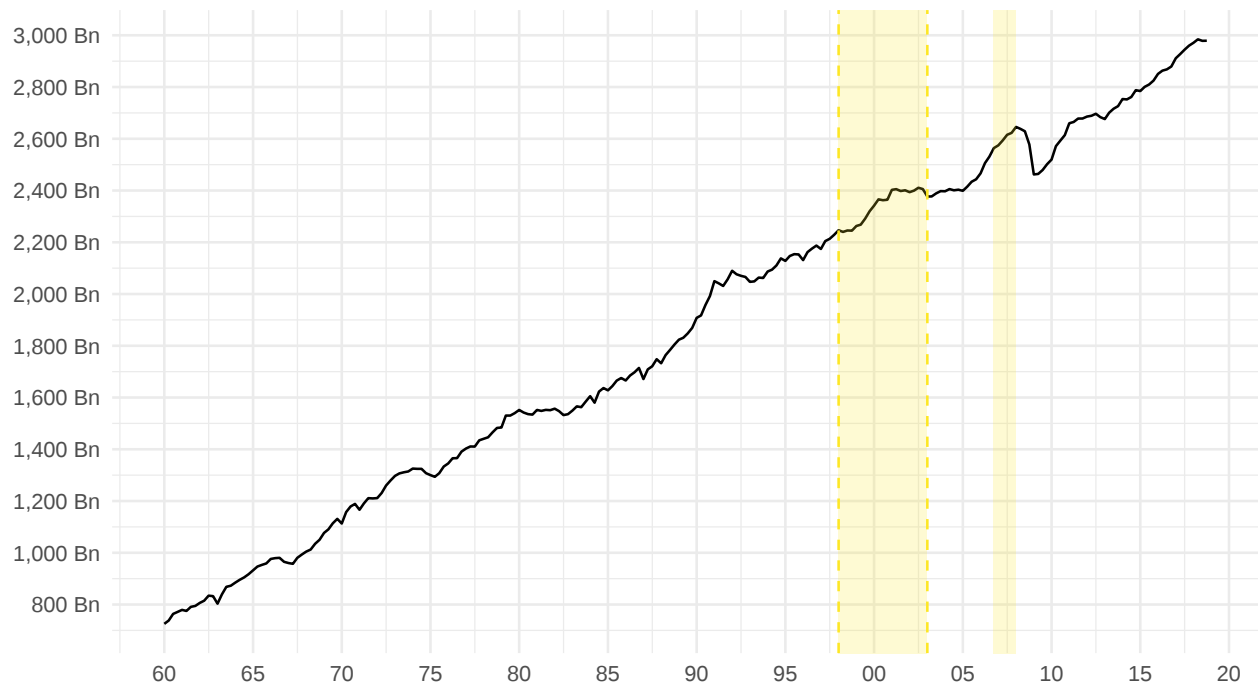


Figure 16: GROSS DOMESTIC PRODUCT.

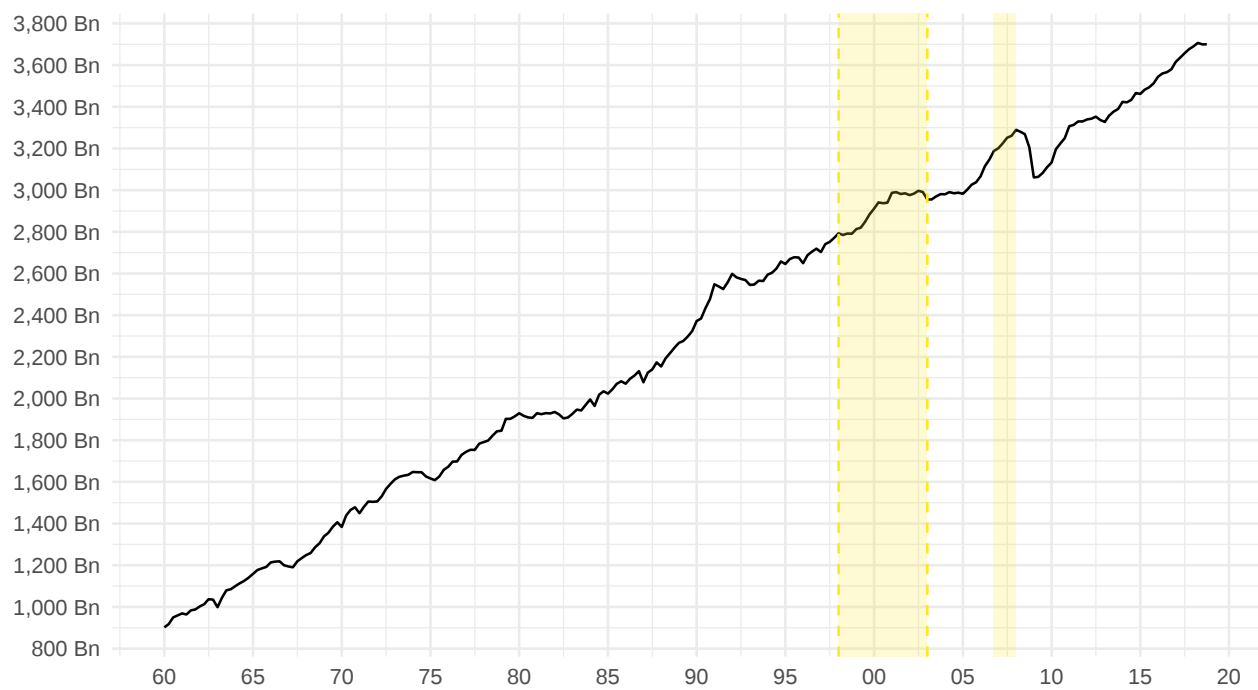


Figure 17: GROSS DOMESTIC PRODUCT.

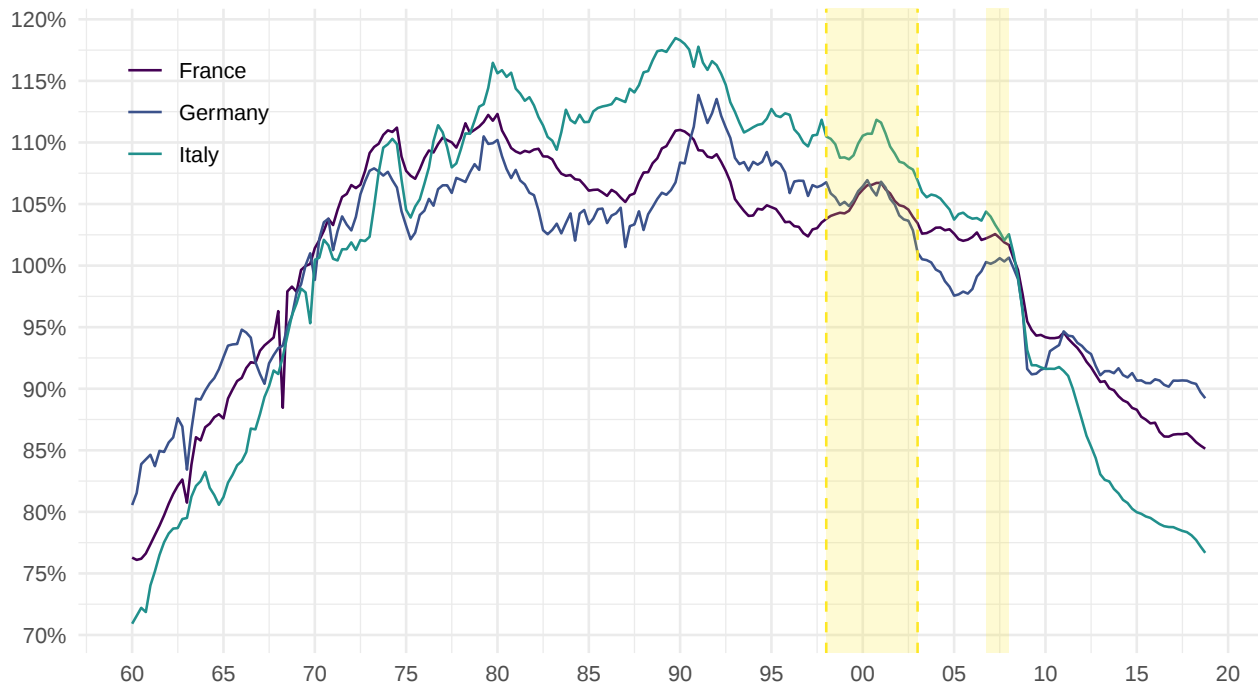


Figure 18: GROSS DOMESTIC PRODUCT.

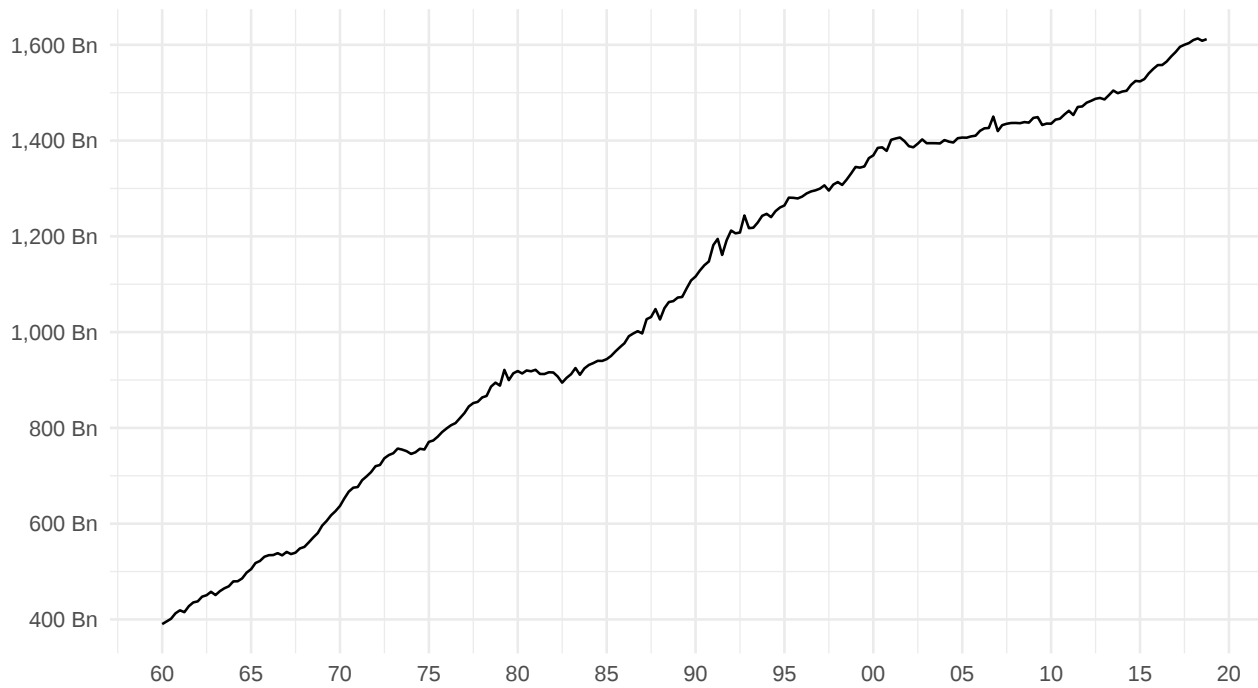


Figure 19: GROSS DOMESTIC PRODUCT.

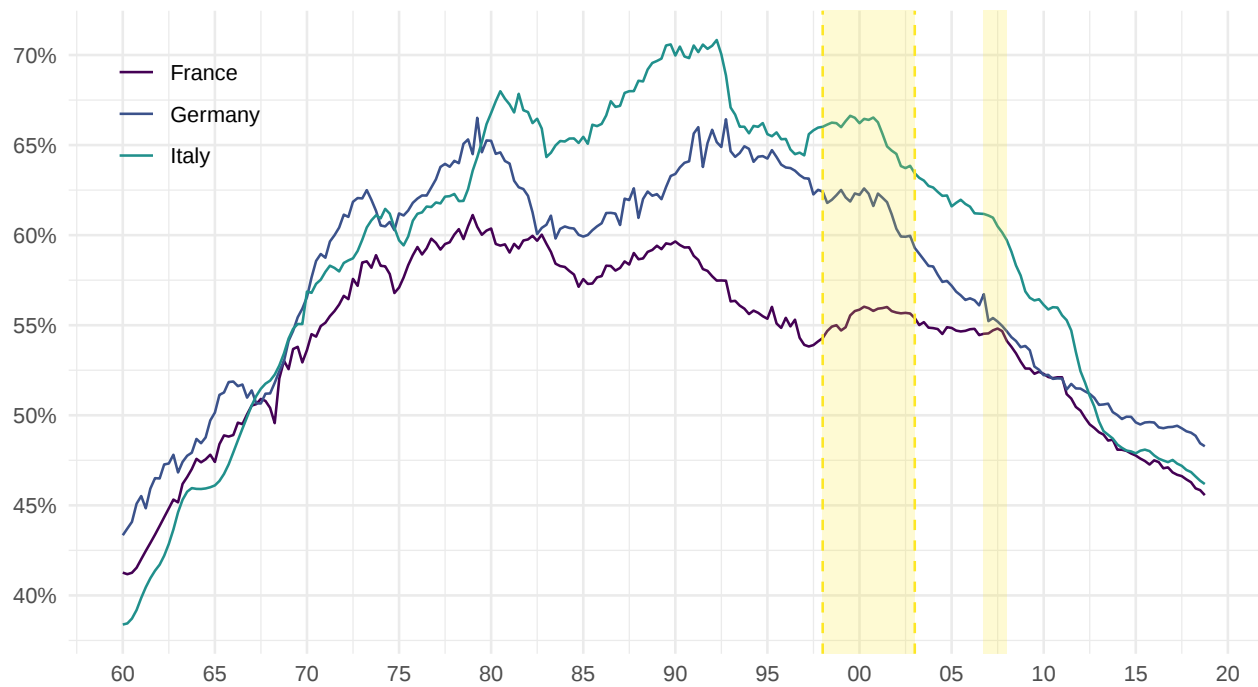


Figure 20: GROSS DOMESTIC PRODUCT.

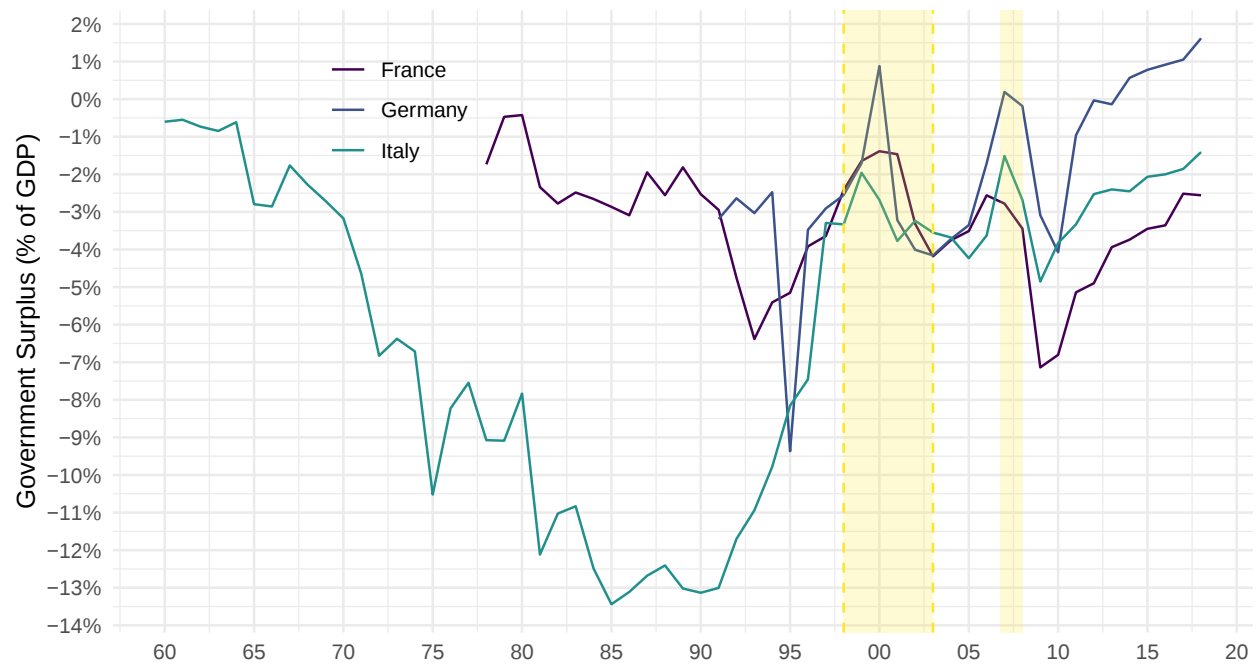


Figure 22: GOVERNMENT DEFICIT.

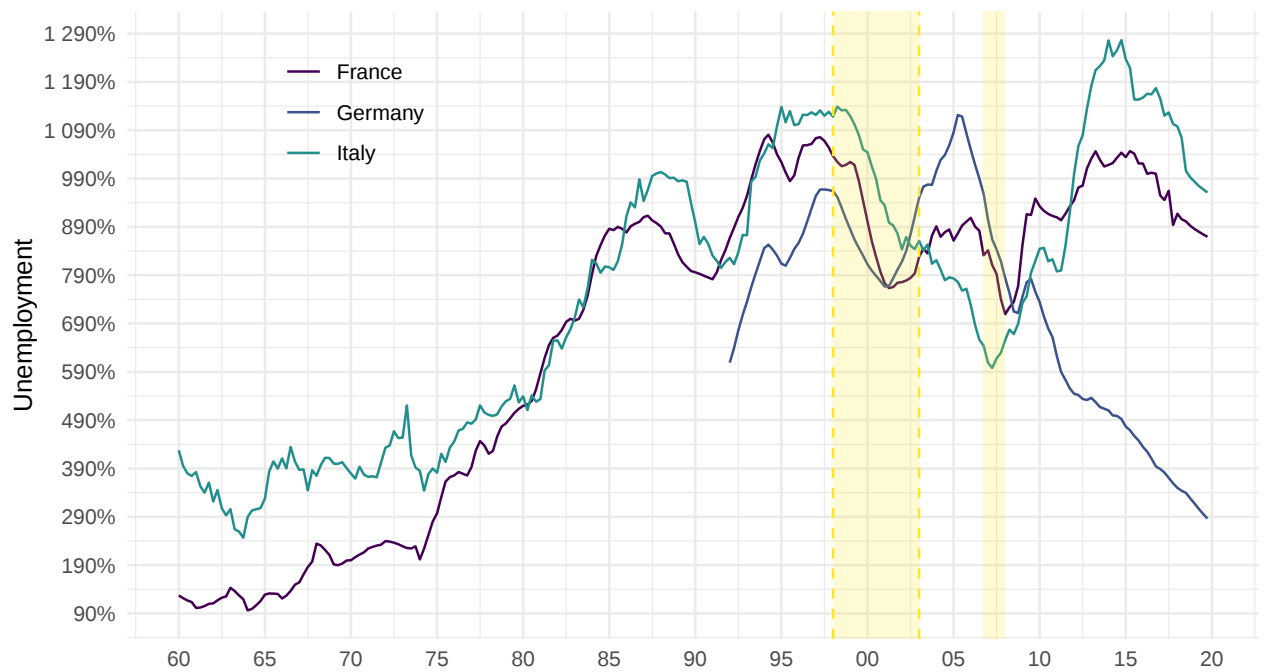


Figure 23: UNEMPLOYMENT.

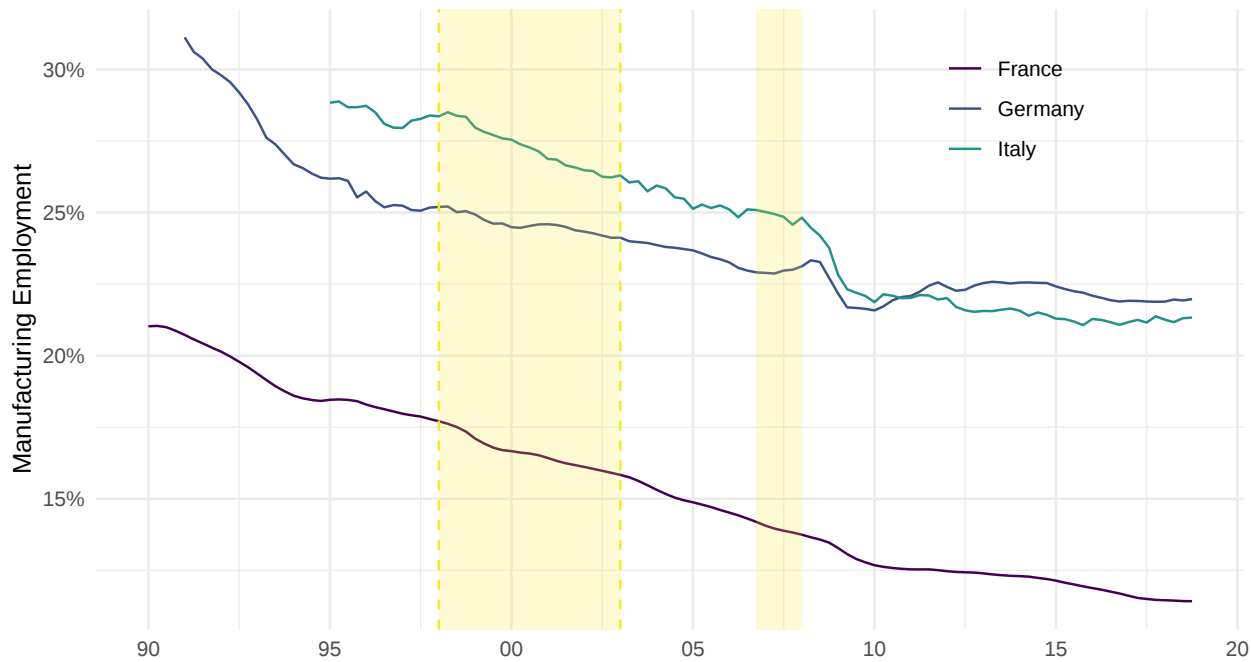


Figure 24: MANUFACTURING EMPLOYMENT.

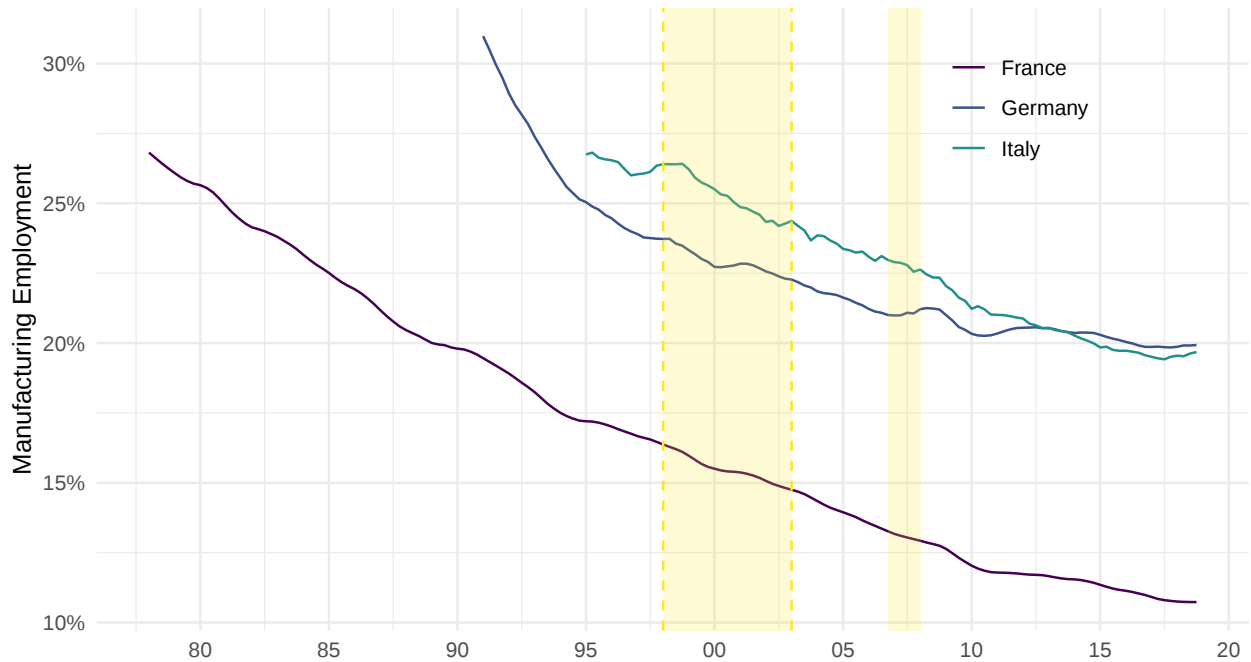


Figure 25: MANUFACTURING EMPLOYMENT.

Import compression in Germany: **1998-2005**.

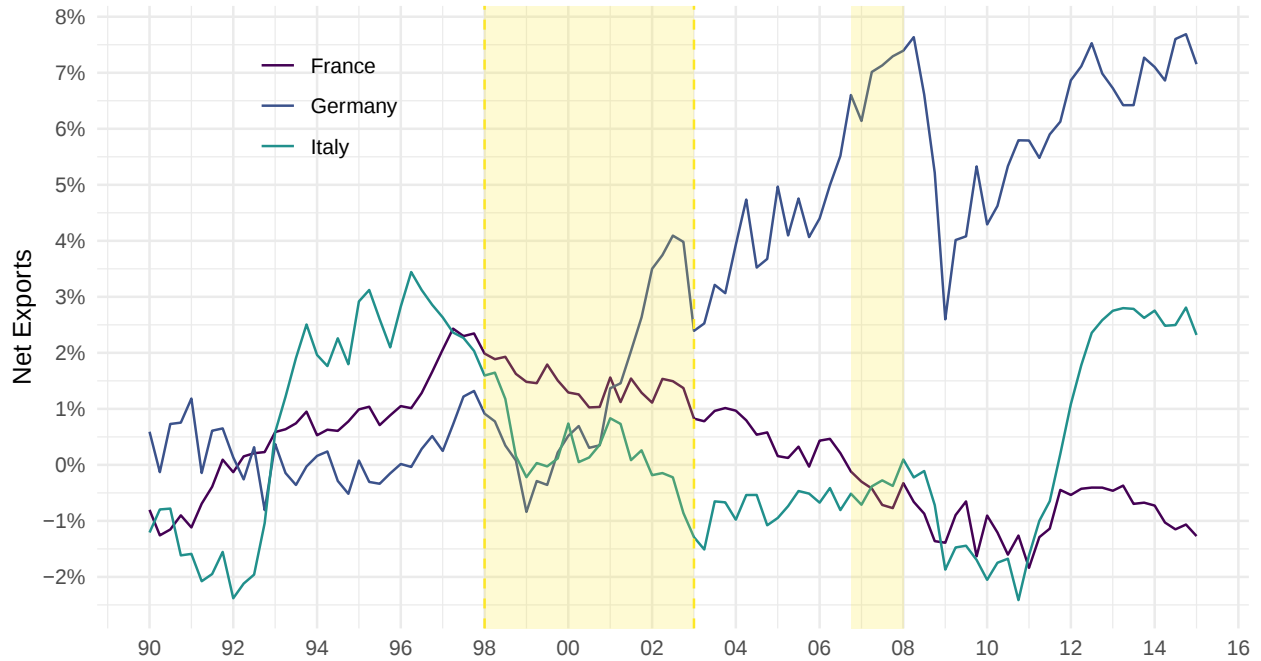


Figure 26: NET EXPORTS.

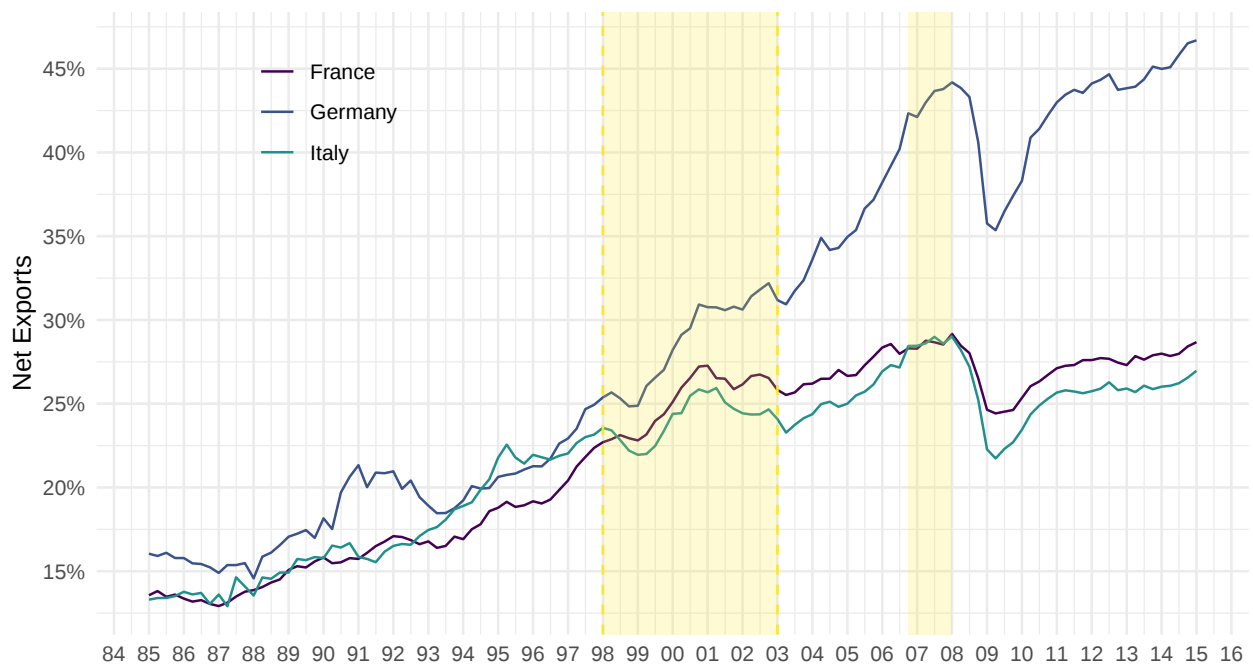


Figure 27: IMPORTS.

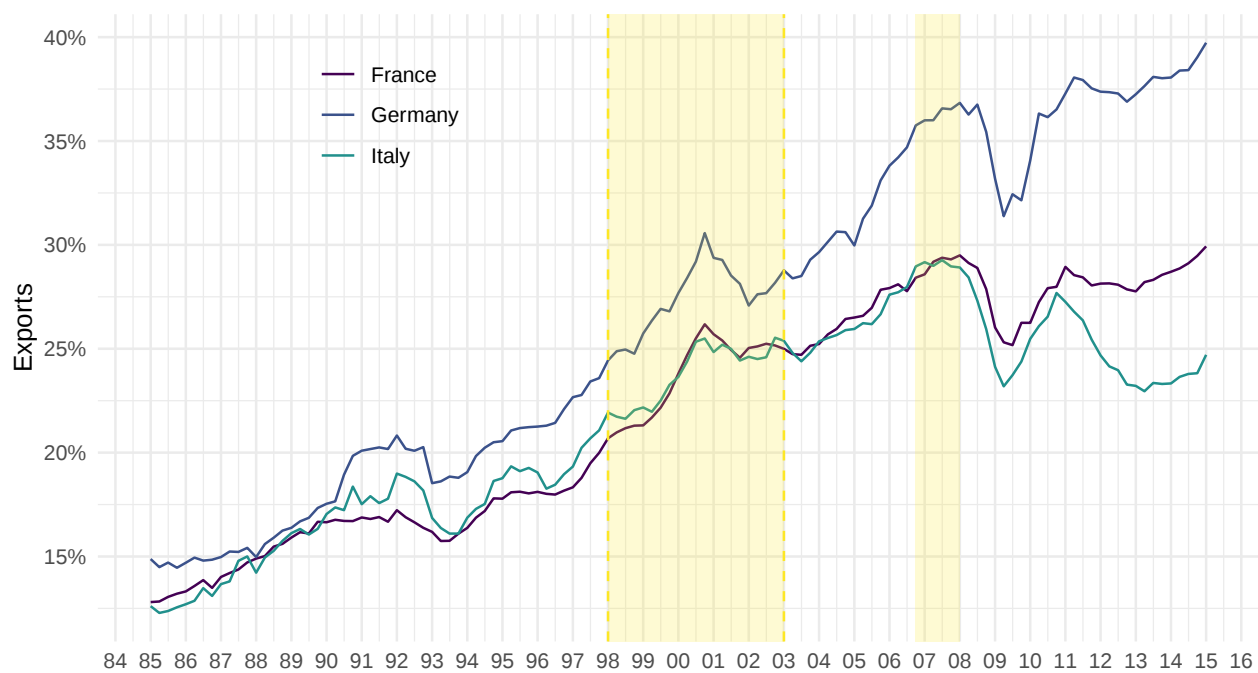


Figure 28: EXPORTS.

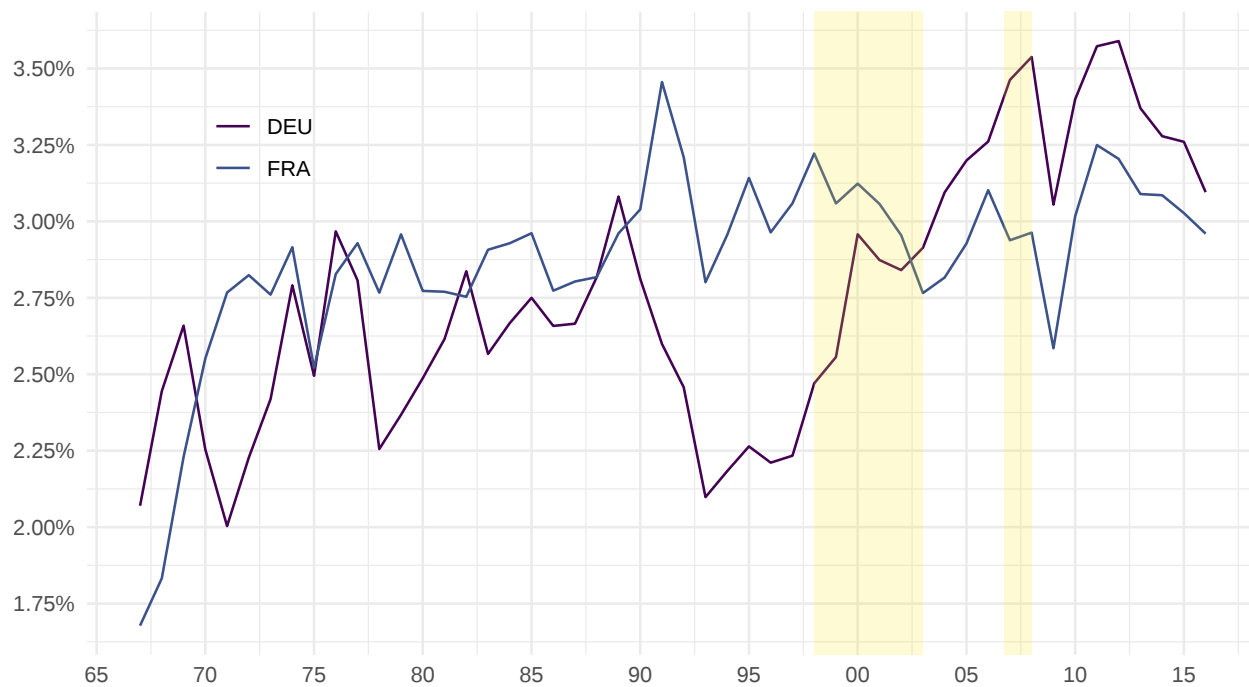


Figure 29: CEPII EXPORTS FRANCE, GERMANY (% OF GDP)
